The activities

INSPIRE focuses on the development of entrepreneurial thinking to drive discovery, creativity and innovation primarily for HE students but also for VET and aims to train 120 HE and VET students that will be eligible for certification, according to the standards of 17024, as well as recognition of their knowledge, via ECTS.

- Foster entrepreneurial thinking to drive discovery, creativity and innovation in HE and VET students.
- Develop a personalised pathway for students in order to help them develop those competences that identify with their own training needs
- Develop a Training Needs Analysis tool and a curricula for the innovative, entrepreneurial student
- Develop Training material/ Classroom, PBL that corresponds to those LO's and has been proven to promote innovation and discovery.
- Train at least 120 HE and VET students that will have the chance to validate their knowledge.
- Validate the acquired knowledge via the development of a certification scheme and the awarding of ECTS points.
- Development and promotion of a Multilingual Online open e-learning/networking space
