The European ECVET Curriculum provides a reference of **competences in Ecodesign for sustainable Creative and Cultural Industries**, using a common language to describe competences, skills, knowledge and proficiency levels that can be understood across Europe, following European standards and frameworks of reference such as the EQF. This output is designed to meet the needs of VET and in-company teachers, trainers and managers working to support I-VET and C-VET students on how to apply Ecodesign principles for sustainable CCI.

The aim is to serve as a common basis for the elaboration of syllabuses, curriculum guidelines, examinations, textbooks, etc. across Europe. It describes in a comprehensive way what learners have to learn and what knowledge and skills they have to develop so as to be able to act effectively in the application of Ecodesign principles for sustainable Creative and Cultural Industries. It provides the means for educational administrators, course designers, teachers, teacher trainers, examining bodies, etc., to reflect on their current practice, with a view to situating and co-ordinating their efforts and to ensuring that they meet the real needs of the learners for whom they are responsible.
