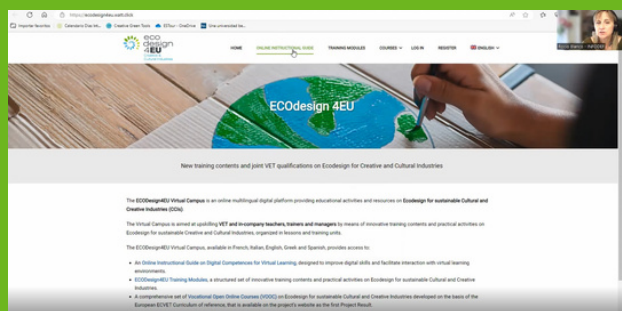
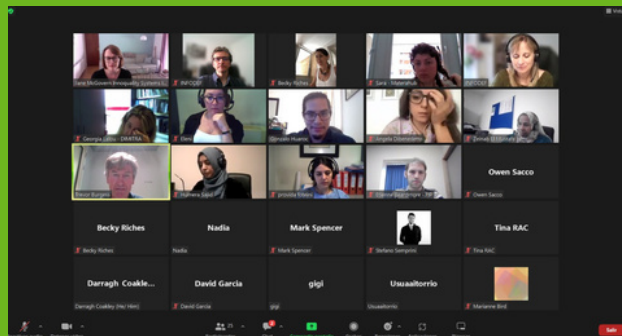




On July 4th, 2023, participants from all partner countries joined EcoDesign4EU's enlightening online capacity building session, diving deep into the Virtual Campus platform's features.
