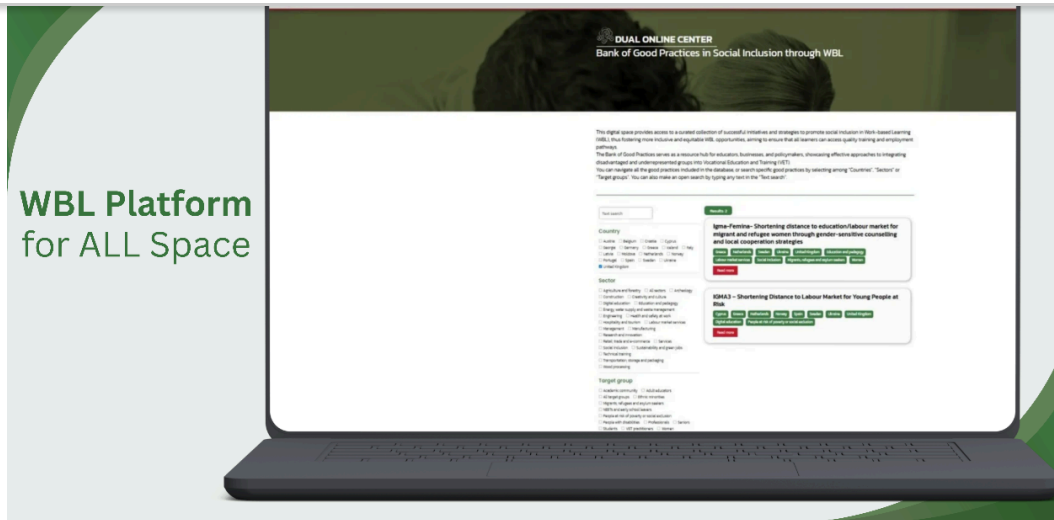

SMEs Quality Apprenticeship Supporting Programme

The **SMEs Quality Apprenticeship Supporting Programme** is designed to help small and medium-sized enterprises to participate in **high-quality apprenticeship training programmes**.

Led by FH Salzburg as part of WP 3 - Dual Online Centre, the programme will be completed in May 2026. It's structured around **four key areas**:

- Developing a more **green** and **digital quality apprenticeship programme**

- **Post-training transitions** and evaluation

The programme will provide practical tools and **Best Practices** to support the **digital** and **green transition**. Additionally it pays special attention to promoting **diversity, shared values** and **equality**.

The **Training course on design and management of Green, Digital and Inclusive Apprenticeship** will be completed at the beginning of 2026. The course is tailored to VET teachers

The Training course, as well as a variety of other MOOCs, will be available on the **Online Training Platform**. The multilingual platform will help VET teachers and in-company trainers adapt training to the changing green and digital transitions. The **MIC - Micro-credentials Certification Center** is being developed to validate courses in the Online Training Center as well as prior learning. The MIC enables the certification and validation of short-term learning experiences and previously acquired competences in the Habitat sector, which will be available [here](#).

The **SMART Career Guidance Assistant** is a multilingual assistant that offers personalized career guidance based on AI. By analyzing user profiles, including their skills, interests, and learning history, the assistant identifies potential career opportunities as well as skill gaps and links these to other project results (such as the Sector Map of Jobs and Skills).
