Final Conference of the Greencomp School Project | 20–21 March 2026 Volos, Greece

The GreenComp School project will conclude with its Final Conference and last Transnational Project Meeting (TPM) on 20–21 March 2026 in Volos, Greece, hosted by the University of Thessaly at the Pedagogical Department of Primary Education.

The Conference will present the project's main results, policy recommendations, and validated educational tools to educators, institutional representatives, and stakeholders. Sessions will address the European perspective on Green Competences, the validation of GreenComp in school contexts, dissemination impact, and the digitalisation process.

Interactive workshops will demonstrate how board games, gamification strategies, and participatory activities support sustainability education in primary schools.



Pilot Phase & Online Games – Final Results

During the event, the consortium will present the outcomes of the European pilot phase involving Higher Education students, teachers, pupils, and parents. The results will confirm the effectiveness of the 24 training courses, the micro-credentials framework, and the digital learning platform.

Stakeholders will also be introduced to the final version of the online games and participatory mobile tools, which will demonstrate strong engagement, collaborative learning, and practical application of GreenComp competences in classroom and community settings.
