

### 3<sup>RD</sup> TPM IN CYPRUS

In June 2024, the important partnership meeting dedicated to the development of the Micro-credential Training Course, within the framework of Work Package 3 (WP3), will be held in Cyprus, with the University of Thessaly (UTH) as the lead institution. During the WP3 workshop, an in-depth peer review of the GreenComp School Curriculum and training materials key components of the project, was carried out. This review provided valuable feedback, promoting in-depth discussions on methodologies and content. Participants identified areas for strategic improvement, agreeing on actions needed to refine the curriculum and improve the overall quality of the learning materials for each competence.



The WP3 workshop was a crucial step in moving the project forward, strengthening collaboration between partners and ensuring that quality objectives are effectively pursued. The possible extension will provide an opportunity to finalise the materials with greater attention to detail, ensuring a positive and lasting impact.

## AN INNOVATIVE COURSE FOR SUSTAINABLE EDUCATION

The GreenComp School course equips future and in-service primary teachers with the tools to integrate sustainability into the classroom, fostering a "sustainable mindset" in the next generation. Grounded in the Erasmus+ GreenComp School research, the project has adapted the 12 European green competences—including the enhanced "Collective Action and Collaboration"—specifically for the primary school context.

To support this, two comprehensive 300-hour blended curricula have been developed: one for Vocational Education and Training (VET) focused on continuous professional development, and one for Higher Education (HE) for student teachers.



## DEVELOPMENT OF TRAINING TOOLS FOR PUPILS & PARENT

The GreenComp School project introduces innovative tools designed to bridge the gap between school and home, fostering a collaborative sustainability mindset for both students and parents. By utilizing Project-Based Learning (PBL), in-class initiatives, and interactive board games, the project transforms complex environmental concepts into enjoyable, hands-on experiences. This interdisciplinary approach ensures that sustainability moves beyond the classroom, empowering the next generation and their families to integrate eco-conscious practices into their daily lives through meaningful, real-world problem-solving.
