Day 1: Strategy and Global Impact The opening day focuses on the project's foundational achievements. Following an introduction by Professor Stavroula Kaldi (University of Thessaly) and insights into EU policy, the session dives into the project's key results. Partners from Frederick University, MMC, DIMITRA, and TUCEP will present on validating the GreenComp framework, developing micro-credentialed teacher training, and utilizing digital tools to maximize the project's social and environmental impact.

Day 2: Innovative Classroom Workshops The second day is dedicated to hands-on learning through three specialized workshops. Educators and stakeholders will work alongside experts from DIMITRA, Frederick University, and UTH to design and implement sustainability games, participatory family activities, and digital learning tools. This practical approach ensures that attendees leave with concrete strategies to cultivate a green mindset in primary school children.
